Graduate Employment Information: The program employment rate is the percentage of graduated students who enrolled in the Licensed Practical Nurse program between July 1, 2014 and June 30, 2015, and became employed in the Licensed Practical and Licensed Vocational Nurses Occupation. Out of a total number of 19 students that graduated in the cohorts enrolled between July 1, 2014 and June 30, 2015, 18 graduates (96%) got employed within 175% of program length as reported to the accrediting agency (ACCSC).
